












## YARDAGE MARKERS

### **LOCAL RULES**

The game of golf shall be played in accordance to the rules currently adopted by the royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, the USGA and in conjunction with the rules of Laquna Golf Bintan.

#### 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27)

Out of bounds is defined by white stakes, painted lines and/or fences bordering the golf course.

#### 2. Water Hazards (Rule 26)

- a) Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes and/or painted lines.
- b) Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes and/or painted lines.
- c) Additional drop zones; as an added option where provided, where a player may elect to take relief under a penalty of one shot.

#### 3 Free Relief

The golfer is entitled to take free relief when a ball lies in or on an obstruction, or when the obstruction interferes with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing.

- a) GUR areas marked with white paint, white rope and/or a GUR sign.
- b) Concrete drains, manhole covers, sprinkler heads and control boxes.
- c) Artificially made roadways and/or pathways (not including cut grass walkways around tees).
- d) Young trees marked with stakes, tree stumps (under two club lengths high) and/or tree roots.
- e) Tee signs, distance/yardage markers and rubbish bins.
- f) Hazard stakes, except when the ball lies within the hazard.
- g) Rain shelters, kiosks and halfway huts.
- h) Edging grooves around the shoulder of the green and cart path.
- i) Embedded (plugged) ball through the green, except in a hazard.
- j) Animal Nesting Hole inside a bunker (Rule 25 the ball must be dropped inside the bunker)
- k) Wood ties around the golf course.
- I) Stones in bunkers are classed as movable obstructions, and may be moved without penalty (Rule 24-1).
- m) Flower beds and landscape areas marked with a blue stake.

#### 4. Waste/Woodchip Areas

All waste and/or woodchip areas are to be treated as "through the green" as defined by the Rules of Golf. The club may be grounded in these areas as they are not considered hazards.
